Stoughton Utilities donates to Medication Disposal and Sharps Collection Event

Stoughton Utilities donated \$200 to the Stoughton Wellness Coalition for their Medication Disposal and Sharps Collection Event. The donation came from Stoughton Utilities and their power provider WPPI as part of their Community Contributions program, through which the utility is able to make contributions to the community in various ways.

The Medication Disposal and Sharps Collection Event allowed Stoughton area residents to drop off unused medication containers and sharps products for proper disposal. The first event, which was held at the Stoughton Fire Department in September 2008, was a huge success. It brought in 269 pounds of medication, 139,000 pills, and 132 pounds of sharps products. The Coalition plans to hold another event in the spring of 2009.
