Stoughton Utilities RoundUp Program Donates \$1,100 to The Friends of the Stoughton Public Library

Jeanne Burt of The Friends of the Stoughton Public Library recently accepted a check for \$1,100 from Utilities Finance and Administrative Manager Kim Jennings of Stoughton Utilities. This donation is part of Stoughton Utilities' RoundUP program, a voluntary program that 'rounds up' customers' utility bills to the next whole dollar. All proceeds are distributed to and benefit local community organizations.

The Friends of the Stoughton Public Library will use the funds to support children's, young adult, and adult programs throughout the year, which will assist in educating, entertaining, enriching, and empowering our community. Examples of such programs include the children's summer reading program, the Lucky Day Program for adult best sellers, and large print books. The Friends of the Stoughton Public Library are devoted to promoting and improving library services, materials, and facilities and encouraging the broadest possible use of the library.

Stoughton Utilities began the RoundUP program in 2006 as a way to further assist local non-profit organizations in our community. In 2012 the program collected and awarded \$2,600 in funds to four local organizations. Over five percent of Stoughton Utilities customers have voluntarily chosen to participate in the program and are continuing the "neighbor helping neighbor" concept that founded Stoughton Utilities over a century ago.
